

MORE Ways to Save On Electric Vehicles!

MOR-EV offers several ways to save on electric vehicles and trucks.



MOR-EV Cars

Eligible vehicles and dealerships are featured on the website or on MOR-EV.org. Eligible vehicles include battery electric and fuel cell vehicles. MOR-EV car rebates may be redeemed at the point-of-sale with a participating dealer or applied for post-purchase depending on program requirements. MOR-EV is NOT a tax credit.

MOR-EV Standard Rebate	MOR-EV Used Rebate
Receive \$3,500 for the purchase or lease of a new eligible electric vehicle. This rebate is open to Massachusetts residents, businesses and non-profit organizations. Apply for this rebate online post-purchase or lease or receive at point-of-sale at participating dealerships.	Receive a \$3,500 rebate for the purchase or lease of an eligible used electric vehicle. This rebate is open to income-qualifying Massachusetts residents. This rebate requires a prequalification to redeem at point-of-sale.

MOR-EV Trucks

Massachusetts residents, businesses, non-profit organizations, educational institutions and local, municipal and state governments can apply for post-purchase rebates for battery electric (BEV) or fuel cell electric (FCEV) pick-ups and Class 2b – 8 vehicles.

Pick-Ups and Class 2b Vehicles	Class 3-8 Vehicles
Receive a \$7,500 rebate for the purchase or lease of an eligible pick-up truck with a GVWR between 6,000 – 10,000 lbs. or other vehicles with a GVWR between 8,501 – 10,000 lbs.	Receive a rebate for the purchase or lease of an eligible truck, bus, or van with a GVWR exceeding 10,000 lbs. This rebate requires a voucher reservation request prior to taking delivery. Maximum rebate levels depend on the vehicle class and current value block for rebates.
